



Follow the directions below (using Google Chrome) after you have downloaded Snagit for Chrome.

I. Create a Presentation in Google Slides, or Upload a Presentation (PowerPoint or Keynote) to Google Drive







II. Open and Record Your Presentation

5. After you have opened your Google Slides Presentation and are ready to record, look for the Snagit button on the top right of your browser...






7. Select the screen you would like to record. I want to record my presentation, so I'm clicking on the second option. You can also record your whole screen or any other windows you may have open.




RECORDING BEGINS AFTER YOU PUSH SHARE.

Your screen and all audio is now being recorded. You can move about the screen, play your presentation to narrate it, switch pages, etc.



III. Preview & Save

- 10. Your video automatically saves to Google Drive in a folder called TechSmith. This screen allows you to:
 - a. Playback your video.
 - b. Name your video. (Only after it has uploaded to Google Drive. This may take a few minutes depending on the length of your video and the connection speed.)
 - c. Choose save/share options.
 - d. **Get the link to share or upload to YouTube.** Google Drive seems to work on more school networks. You can always get the link later from your Google Drive account
 - e. Exit & finish your recording.





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
